#### **Return to School Reminders**

- Clearly labelled water bottles will be necessary so please ensure your child has one made available each day. These should be taken home each day, washed thoroughly, and brought back to school.

- iPads need to be brought into school fully charged each day.

#### P.E. Kit for Summer Term
