


Primary 2 Curriculum Overview February- April 2021
Context for Learning- Scotland/Fairtrade

<p>Social Studies and Sciences</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. We will continue with our Famous Scots topic by learning about Scottish artists and sculptures. Our main focus will be on Charles Rennie Mackintosh. We will create some artwork in the style of CRM as well as using various media to be creative and inventive.2. During Science week we will focus on Electricity, where it comes from, its uses and be informed about the dangers and safety when using electrical equipment.3. Through the story Handa's Surprise we will be learning about Fairtrade which will allow children to identify the countries where some of their food is grown and look at how it is grown and the packaging.
<p>Language</p> 	<p>We will be covering a wide variety of language activities in class. All children will develop their reading, spelling and handwriting through daily activities. In grammar, we will be developing our understanding of adjectives and verbs, learning about the difference between past and present tense, and the use of openers. We will be working on incorporating the grammar taught in our written work. Our main focus in writing will be persuasive writing, which will include posters and leaflets. Reading will be carried out in class and will focusing on strategies needed to help us read fluently and with understanding.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>We will continue to focus on the concept of multiplying using arrays/repeated addition as well as division through grouping and sharing. We will also have the opportunity to introduce fractions such as halves and quarters. During this block, we will also revisit and consolidate addition and subtraction within 100.</p> <p>We will also be focusing on money and information handling.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Linked to our context for learning the children will be introduced to different Scottish artists and sculptors They will be using various materials to replicate their ideas such as clay, lego, junk materials, which will allow them to be creative and imaginative.</p> <p>The children will have the opportunity to listen to and make music from various Fairtrade countries we learn about.</p>
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>Linked to our science week the children will have the opportunity to investigate electricity and electrical circuits.</p>

 <p>Health and Well Being</p>	<p><u>Personal and social development:</u> During online learning, children were introduced to Emotion Works and the different coloured cogs. We will continue working on the cogs this term.</p> <p>PE- Mrs Royan will be carrying out a block of work outdoors so please remember to send extra layers of PE clothes and a waterproof coat on PE days.
