



Primary 3 Curriculum Overview February- April 2021

Context for Learning - Fairtrade

<p>Social Studies and Sciences</p> 	<p>Our Context for Learning (CFL) this term will be cover 3 areas.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Famous Scots -we will continue learning about Famous Scots with a focus on Charles Rennie Mackintosh (CRM). We will create art work in the style of CRM and other Scottish artists using a variety of media. 2. Electricity - we will become inventors during Science week with a focus on electricity. We will learn about who discovered it, its uses and its dangers. 3. Fairtrade - a block of learning about Fairtrade will allow the children to identify the countries and products involved. The children will research and discuss the lives of farmers/children who are involved in the production of products and make comparisons between their lives and ours.
<p>Language</p> 	<p>We will cover a wide range of language and literacy in class. All children will develop their reading, spelling and handwriting through daily activities. This block, our writing will mainly be imaginative writing, taking on a storyline approach linked to CFL as well as personal texts for example: biographies.</p> <p>During online learning our focussed grammar work was developing our understanding of similes, metaphors, adverbs, alliteration and the terms plural and singular (add s and es) We will continue building on these and using them in different contexts before moving onto dictionary skills, alphabetical ordering and compound words.</p> <p>Reading- this will be carried out in class and we will be focussing on strategies needed to help us read fluently and with understanding. They will be heard regularly in class with follow up activities and comprehension. The diary will record progress and be sent home periodically, just ask and we will send it home with your child.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>During this term we will spend time consolidating mental strategies for tackling problems and speeding up recall of key number bonds and times tables facts. We will be looking at area/fractions. During the term we'll also revise and build on our prior learning in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; developing a variety of strategies to complete problems, including formal written methods. We will also be focussing on money and information handling as well as building on our prior learning of mapping and angles.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Music: The children have the opportunity to listen and make music from the various Fairtrade countries we learn about.</p> <p>Art and Craft: Linked to the works of Charles Rennie Mackintosh and other Scottish artists the children will work with different media to design and create their own masterpieces in the style of their chosen artist.</p>
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>Linked to our Science week the children will have the opportunity to explore, be inventive and creative with electrical circuits.</p>
<p>Health and</p> 	<p>Personal and social development: During online learning, children were introduced to Emotion Works and the different coloured cogs. We will continue working on the cogs this term.</p>

Wellbeing	<p>PE- Mrs Royan will be carrying out a block of work outdoors so please remember to send extra layers of PE clothes and a waterproof coat on PE days. In addition, children will be finding out about how exercise helps to keep us healthy.</p> <p>P3G- Fridays</p> <p>P3M-Wednesdays</p> <p><u>PLEASE ENSURE NO JEWELLERY TO BE WORN ON THESE DAYS.</u> Children with longer hair should ensure their hair is tied back. Religious and Moral Education	<p>The pupils will be learning about Easter and the celebrations and traditions associated with this time of year. There will also be a link to Fairtrade and chocolate production.</p>
