Context for Learning – Scottish History – 'Disasters and Successes, Battles and Thrones' – an exploration of significant events, people, and times in Scottish History.


Context for Learning




The pupils will continue with their science topic started before Christmas until the February break. After the February break pupils will be exploring significant times, events and people in Scottish history, comparing and contrasting and investigating how its impacted life today. Pupils will

- use primary and secondary sources selectively to research events in the past
- interpret historical evidence from a range of periods to help to build a picture of Scotland's heritage and my sense of chronology
- investigate a Scottish historical theme to discover how past events or the actions of individuals or groups have shaped Scottish society
- compare and contrast a society in the past with my own and contribute to a discussion of the similarities and differences
- discuss why people and events from a particular time in the past were important, placing them within a historical sequence
