This term in nursery we are getting out and about in Eyemouth spotting signs of spring. The children have been up in the woods and over to Netherbyres using their different senses to detect the changes that show spring is coming – seeing snowdrops, smelling the wild garlic and listening to the birds. We have a child attending nursery who has been diagnosed with anaphylaxis due to a serious allergic reaction to mango, pineapple and lentils and beans.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND MANGO, PINEAPPLE, LENTILS or BEANS INTO NURSERY IN YOUR CHILD'S SNACK OR LUNCH, or any products containing these items (smoothies, yoghurt etc).

Thank you so much for your cooperation in helping us keep everyone safe. NB: If your child develops an allergic reaction to any substance or foodstuff, please alert nursery immediately so that we can update their Personal Plan, share with all staff and ensure that they do not come into contact with the item while in our care. Thank you.
