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### Wellbeing Passports

As part of our ongoing approaches to Inclusion and Wellbeing, this term we have been creating Wellbeing Passports for identified children to support them in accessing their learning. A Wellbeing Passport is a child friendly document completed with your child and their Class Teacher. It is used to outline what your child enjoys, how best to support them in accessing their learning, strategies for self-regulation and giving them clear targets to support them with engaging and achieving in their learning. Class Teachers will notify you via Showbie if your child has had a passport written and these will also be uploaded onto their portfolio for you to access. A reminder that children should not bring in their own footballs to school. We have many school footballs which the children can use during break and lunchtime. Also please note that football tops are not allowed to be worn in school, including non-uniform days. Please do not send your child to school wearing one.
