



Literacy

- In reading, we will get started again with our Read, Write Inc groups. The children will learn the sounds they need to make progress and will be practising sounding out and developing fluency.
- Reading Homework will be given regularly. This may include keywords to learn, a Read, Write Inc book or worksheet, a graded reader, e.g. Biff. Chip and Kipper, or Reading Eggs activities.
- Repetition and practice at home are essential. Please bring your reading packet to school each day, and sign the reading diary when completed each night.
- In writing we will be learning to write sentences to describe different objects. They will be learning to use capital letters and full stops. Some children will be encouraged to use joining words to make longer sentences.

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be going on a Voyage of Discovery to find out 'An Eyemouth Timeline'.

We will be learning:

- about some of the special places in Eyemouth e.g. the church and the harbour.
- to compare life in the past with our own lives today, how places and things change
- to use artefacts e.g. photographs, museum objects to help us learn about the past.
- about the people who have been involved in developing Eyemouth
- learning about maps and directions.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Revision of simple calculations, addition and subtraction strategies, both mental and written., talking about strategies,
- Numbers to 100, counting forwards and backwards, recognition of numerals.
- Learning about different ways of collecting and displaying information about ourselves, e.g. charts and graphs.
- We will be looking at maps and giving simple directions.
- More information will be sent home later with ideas of maths games to do at home.

Important Information

In Primary 2 we are developing the basic literacy and numeracy building blocks. Repetition and practice are essential for success and mastery. You can help by:

- Reading with your child, bedtime stories, listening to them reading, joining the library and developing a love of stories.

In P.E. the children will be working on:

Basic Moves

- Further developing Movement Skills (Running, Jumping, Hopping, Side-stepping, Galloping), Body Control and Spatial Awareness.

Games Skills

- Developing movement skills, body control and spatial awareness.
- Continuing to follow instructions to keep themselves and others safe.
- Developing co-operation skills, working together as a class and in smaller teams.

Object Control

- Further develop motor skills through sliding, rolling, throwing and catching a variety of objects.
- Applying these skills within small games.
