Literacy

Writing

Our focus this term is recount, the children will be given opportunities to write about the experiences they have during their Voyage of discovery visiting different parts of Eyemouth as well as Outdoor Learning.

Reading

Daily opportunities to read in class as well as set reading to be completed at home. Comprehension and grammar will reinforce reading and understanding of the texts.

Spelling

Wraparound spelling lists will be sent home for children to learn and use in class as part of our daily work.

Handwriting

We will practise letter formation and joined up handwriting with the expectation that this will be transferred into daily work.

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be going on a Voyage of Discovery to explore 'An Eyemouth Timeline'.

We will be learning:

About the Eyemouth Fort and 'Black Friday' (The Eyemouth Disaster). We will learn about the key figures in history that had an influence on why the Fort in Eyemouth was built. How treaties were made between countries and battles that took place.

The Eyemouth Disaster and the devastation it caused to our town.

Numeracy & Mathematics

We will focus on:

Place value of numbers up to 1000.

Reasoning and problem solving.

Addition and subtraction within 100.

We will consolidate learning the 2,5,10 times tables as well as beginning to learn the 3 and 4 times tables.

Linked to our Voyage of Discovery we will investigate time, direction and mapping.
