



Literacy

In literacy we are further exploring our knowledge on writing descriptive pieces. We will be focusing on up-levelling our work through word choice, extended sentences and higher-level punctuation.

In reading we are learning to find and use information, in a variety of texts around our topic. We will be developing inferencing skills and exploring different perspectives through the text with supporting evidence.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Refreshing and furthering our knowledge and understanding with numbers to 1,000,000 including decimal numbers.
- Explaining the link between a digit, its place and its value.
- Exploring how to use time in daily activities using and interpreting electronic and paper-based timetables.
- Carrying out practical tasks and investigations involving timed events.
- Looking at the links between time, speed and distance.

Health & Wellbeing

- Develop our Class Charter linked to the UNCRC and the school's values.
- Planning for choice and change
- Building Resilience Unit I

In P.E. the children will be working on:

- Their ability to co-operate with others - engaging positively with their team mates, listening to everyone's point of view respectfully and making collective decisions.
- Developing their team play and decision-making skills within hockey, through drills, overload games and 6 v 6 games.
- Leadership and responsibility within a team.
- This block will culminate in the Eyemouth Cluster Hockey Festival (all P7s).

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be going on a Voyage of Discover based on the theme of 'because we will all be a bit older tomorrow...'

We will be:

- Exploring the needs, discrimination, culture and traditions in our local community.
- Learning about how the local community provide for the needs of the elderly generations of Eyemouth.
- Working with local different service providers to help us understand and gather information of the forms of discrimination that those around us are experiencing and the impact this has on their lives.
- Exploring the cultures, values and customs in our diverse community.
