



Literacy

- This term we will continue to develop our knowledge of single letter and two letter sounds and continue to put these sounds together to read and write 3 letter words. We will learn how to correctly form our letters.
- In writing we will continue to work on drawing detailed pictures in response to a story. We will work on using our pictures to tell a story and using who, what and where questions to develop the detail in our pictures.
- We will also begin to label our drawings and use our imagination to answer story questions.
- We will begin to make predictions about a text and answer questions about a text.
- To develop our listening and talking skills we will continue to have plenty of opportunities to discuss our ideas with a partner and to share our thoughts and news with the class.
- Our class teddy ('Mr Bear') will continue to come home with someone each week, allowing us all the chance to share with the class a little bit about our home lives.
- We will also continue to enjoy story time together.

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be going on a Voyage of Discovery to find out all about water and what makes things go.

We will be learning to:

- Identify the three main states of water.
- The importance of water and how it influences our everyday lives.
- Identify what makes things go, such as batteries, windup toys and sunlight.

In P1 we continue to use a play-based approach to learning so learning focuses will adapt and change with the children's interests.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Through play and more focused teaching activities we will be continuing to work on numbers to 30; counting forwards and backwards, counting objects, talking about the number before and after, ordering and sequencing, and comparing amounts.
- We will continue to explore addition and begin to explore subtraction as well as continuing to practice our number formation.
- In maths we will be learning about time, using digital and analogue clocks as well as calendars to measure time.
- We will also explore position and direction through technologies and mapping skills

- We will also discuss our families and home environments and how these can look the same and different to others.

PE

Striking/Racket Skills:

- Dribbling and pushing a ball with a bat/racket.
- Keepie ups with balloon.
- Striking a ball from a tee.
- Rolling and throwing a small ball.
- Two handed catch.
- Bounce and catch.

Creative Dance:

- Creating sequences of movement in response to a theme.
- Moving in time to a rhythm, beat or music.
- Developing creativity and imagination.
- Performing as part of a group, in front of an audience.
