



### Literacy

- This term we will continue to develop our knowledge of single letter and two letter sounds and continue to put these sounds together to read and write 3 letter words. We will learn how to correctly form our letters.
- In writing we will continue to work on drawing detailed pictures in response to a story. We will work on using our pictures to tell a story and using who, what and where questions to develop the detail in our pictures.
- We will also begin to label our drawings and use our imagination to answer story questions.
- We will begin to make predictions about a text and answer questions about a text.
- To develop our listening and talking skills we will continue to have plenty of opportunities to discuss our ideas with a partner and to share our thoughts and news with the class.
- Our class teddy ('Mr Bear') will continue to come home with someone each week, allowing us all the chance to share with the class a little bit about our home lives.
- We will also continue to enjoy story time together.

### Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be going on a Voyage of Discovery to find out all about life in the past.

We will be learning to:

- Recognise that people in the past lived differently.
- Use our knowledge of the past to demonstrate a difference between our life today and life in the past.
- Identify two different types of evidence which can provide information about the past e.g. family stories, artefacts or pictures.

In PI we continue to use a play-based approach to learning so learning focuses will adapt and change with the children's interests.

### Numeracy & Mathematics

- Through play and more focused teaching activities we will be continuing to work on numbers to 20; counting forwards and backwards, counting objects, talking about the number before and after, ordering and sequencing, and comparing amounts.
- We will continue to explore addition and begin to explore subtraction as well as continuing to practice our number formation.
- In maths we will be learning about time, using digital and analogue clocks as well as calendars to measure time.
- We will also be learning about money, identifying and ordering coins up to £2.

- We will talk about people who can help us when we feel unsafe.
- The children will be able to name the emergency services and understand what it means to phone 999.
- We will also explore medicines and medicine safety.
- We will continue to discuss the 'Zones of Regulation' in our daily routines and stories.
