Literacy

- In reading, we will continue with our Read, Write Inc groups. The children will learn the sounds they need to make progress and will be practising sounding out and developing fluency.
- Reading Homework will be given each week. Children should practice reading at home 2/3 times per week.
- In listening and talking we will be learning to recite a poem in Scots'. This will be recorded and put on Showbie.
- In writing we will be learning to write an information report. This will be about Eyemouth in the past and each week we will write a about a different subject e.g. toys/games, food, houses etc... to help us with this we will be sending home a survey for the children's grandparents to fill in – please support us with this if you can.

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be learning about Eyemouth in the past and this will be called "Time and Tide".

We will be learning:

- To compare life today with life in the past especially the 60s/70s/80s when grandparents were growing up.
- How some buildings in Eyemouth have changed over time.
- About our harbour and how it has developed
- About the Scots' language in general and the Eyemouth dialect.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Learning about multiplying and dividing and the way we record this e.g. $3 \times 3 = 9$.
- Counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and the primary 3s will learn to count in 4s – this is the first step to learning times tables.
- Primary 3s will begin to use what they've learned to practice the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Learning about time – days, weeks, months, seasons and years as well as telling the time using o'clock, half past and quarter past (P3s will learn quarter to as well).
- Exploring fractions including halves and quarters.

Important Information

P.E

Striking/Ball Skills: Thursday

- Dribbling and pushing a ball with a bat/racket
- Keepie ups with balloon
- Striking a ball from a tee
- Rolling and throwing a small ball
- Two handed catch
- Bounce and catch

Gymnastics Friday

- Learning to perform a broad range of balancing, rolling and jumping skills on the floor mats and on a variety of apparatus.
- Developing individual creativity by linking skills together to create a sequence.
- Learning how core strength helps us perform successfully in Gymnastics
