



Literacy

- We will be enjoying daily stories, songs and rhymes. These will help develop our listening and focus skills.
- We will be encouraging the children to talk about their play, what are we learning and what skills are we using and encouraging contributions to class discussions.
- We will be developing writing skills by drawing detailed pictures, saying a sentence aloud and some children will have a go at writing/copying a sentence
- We will be developing our phonological awareness and start to introduce the single sounds, some children may start to sound out simple words. More information on how we teach reading will be given later.
- Developing pencil grip and correct formation of lowercase letters.

Getting to Know Me, Getting to Know You

Our Voyage will help us to find out more about ourselves, our school and other people.

We will be Reading stories, singing songs, and learning through play. We will be getting outside as much as we can.

We will be learning about people who help us in school and out-with in our local community e.g. coastguard, dentist, fire service, police, NHS.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Shape 2D and 3D, sorting recognising and exploring in lots of different ways.
- Pattern, spotting and exploring patterns in their own and the wider environment, copying, continuing and creating their own patterns.
- Numeral formation to 10, counting forwards and backwards, recognition of bigger number and counting amounts.
- Learning about different ways of collecting and displaying information about ourselves, e.g. charts and graphs.
- More information will be sent home later with ideas of maths games to do at home.

Basic Moves

- Further developing Movement Skills (Running, Jumping, Hopping, Side-stepping, Galloping), Body Control and Spatial Awareness.

Games Skills

- Developing movement skills, body control and spatial awareness.
- Continuing to follow instructions to keep themselves and others safe.
- Developing co-operation skills, working together as a class and in smaller teams.

Object Control

- Further develop motor skills through sliding, rolling, throwing and catching a variety of objects.
- Applying these skills within small games.
