



Literacy

This term we will be focusing on descriptive writing, using our class novel and local landscape as inspiration. We will also recap the different steps of creating a great piece of writing.

We will be exploring books in reading groups and working on predicting, summarising and visualising. Children will have a book from their group and one of choice from our school library to encourage reading for enjoyment in school and at home.

In listening and talking, children will be working on collaborating effectively, sharing confidently and tasks linked to our school values and class charter.

In spelling we will use a variety of written and active methods to help us learn new words. There will be a mixture of tricky common words and the root of words before expanding them in different ways.

Voyage of Discovery

This term we will be answering the question "How does Eyemouth's landscape help the population?"

We will be learning:

- To explore, describe and recreate features of Eyemouth's local landscape in model form.
- To Investigate how the land is used and how this supports local people.
- To use maps, photographs and observations to explore our local area and compare natural and human made features as well as how it has changed over time.
- To consider how we can care for and improve our local area.

We will all be exploring materials through practical investigations linked to our class novel George's Marvellous Medicine.

Numeracy & Mathematics

This term we will be covering place value in numeracy. This will include recognition of numbers, counting development, ordering and sequencing before moving on to estimation and rounding.

In mathematics we will explore measurement and ideas of chance and uncertainty. Learning will include active tasks, problem solving and opportunities to apply skills across our Voyage of Discovery.
