Writing

We will be undertaking descriptive writing this term. We'll look at how to structure written pieces and how to enhance descriptions and word choice. We'll use our new class novel and class voyage as inspiration for a variety of writing.

Reading

We will enjoy a class novel throughout the term. We'll focus on key reading skills of skimming and scanning texts to answer different kinds of questions. Reading books will continue to be explored within class and brought home as homework. Children will also have time to read AR texts and take quizzes on completed books. Furthermore, the use of the school e-library will be encouraged for reading and audio books.

Listening and Talking

Children will be working on their collaborative group skills during this term in a number of tasks linked to their class voyage and focus on our school values and UNCRC.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Numeracy

This term we'll be covering aspects of Place Value and Addition and Subtraction. This will include counting, ordering, sequencing, estimation and rounding.

In Mathematics we'll investigate probability and patterns and relationships and the impact of mathematics in the real world.

We'll be regularly assigning tasks in the Magma platform to consolidate class lessons and retrieval. Children will also use TT Rockstars to revise and maintain their knowledge and speed of facts.

Health & Wellbeing

We will develop our Class Charters linked to UNCRC and exploring our rights and how these would look in our class and wider school environment. Whole school assemblies will link into this area too.

We'll focus this term on establishing class and playground routines and friendships, relationships and resilience. We'll revisit previous work on feelings and Zones of Regulation.

PE

In P.E. the children will working on:

- Improving their knowledge of various invasion games and tactics used within these.
- Developing their football skills and applying these skills to game situations.
- They will also focus on their ability to work as part of a team, by co-operating well with others and giving positive effort.
